What is an honorary degree?

It is a university qualification which does not require the passing of exams; it is given to a distinguished visitor who has contributed something special to a subject or society.

Competition rules:

- The entry might be a short, illustrated, description of a dream, using words, phrases or sentences.
- Judges will look principally at the language in the text, rather than the quality of any images.
- No entry can be larger than a sheet of A4 paper.
- Pupils should write their name, age, class, teacher and school on the back of their entry.
