

Learn French with Nathalie @Nattalingo – week 1 – for children aged 7-11

Little and often is key!

For starters, look out for a new episode of this every day: [watch the daily French challenge video, learn then practise French throughout the day!](#)

Below are some suggestions to keep you busy through the week.

Day 1

- [Click here to play the animal game](#) : click on the purple owl (animaux, which means animals); then click on the purple speech bubble (jouer, which means play); listen to each sound and click on the animal that makes that sound. “Bravo” means well done. What score did you get? You can play more than once; it is different every time!
- [Watch “le poussin Piou” all the way through](#); enjoy joining in with the words “et le poussin Piou” (which means “and Piou the chick”). Please note: you can slow down the speed of the song to 75%, should you want to.

Day 2

- [watch le poussin Piou until 53 seconds in](#) and join in with the animal noises
- [watch this video to practise the 5 first animals from le poussin Piou](#)

Day 3

- have a break from “le poussin Piou” (!): watch, practise and learn this French nursery rhyme: [une poule sur un mur](#)
- [Click here for activities linked to the nursery rhyme.](#)

Day 4

- [watch le poussin Piou until 53 seconds in](#); try to sing along to the names of the animals: [click here for the words to the song](#) and remember, you can slow down its speed to 75%!

Day 5

- [play the game from day 1 again](#); have several attempts; when you get the hen or the cockerel, make the noise and say the name of the animal in French!

Days 6 & 7: have a break or go back over your favourite bits!
