Below are some suggestions to keep you busy through the week. We are looking at numbers with our animals this week.

Day 1

- [Click here to watch a video \(it is a song\) and learn/revise your numbers 1-10 in French.](#) Keep practising those numbers whenever you can in the day!

Day 2

- [Click here to watch the 1st part of my video telling you what happens when you talk, in French, about more than 1 animal.](#)
- Gather your toy animals and count them, in French!

Day 3
